Federico II University Hospital and Campania Region are organising a Conference for the International day of the Older Persons, aimed at mainstreaming the good practices developed in European Regions and networks in the context of active and healthy ageing.

Health in all policies bridges technologies, life-long learning and age friendly tourism in the effort of turning the challenge of an ageing population into an opportunity of growth and development, by taking advantage of innovative approaches. Successful ageing requires a multidimensional and multidisciplinary approach, where stakeholders across local, national and international levels align their efforts.

The European Innovation Partnership on Active and Healthy Ageing represents an open ecosystem where all stakeholders from health and social systems, enterprise, education, research and citizens association collaborate to share their good practices, improve and scale them up by tailoring to the different locoregional contexts. Since 2013 Campania stakeholders have been contributing to the EIP on AHA in the context of the Action Groups on Frailty and functional decline, Age friendly environment, Fall prevention, Integrated care, Prescription Adherence. Campania Reference Site has been liasing with EU Reference Sites exchanging experiences to identify, support, strengthen and scale up good practices.

Bringing together decision and policy makers with professionals and citizens, the conference has the ambition to facilitate the exploitation of the good practices available in the different domains that influence healthy ageing with a life-course approach that generates opportunities for the local development of a silver economy.
